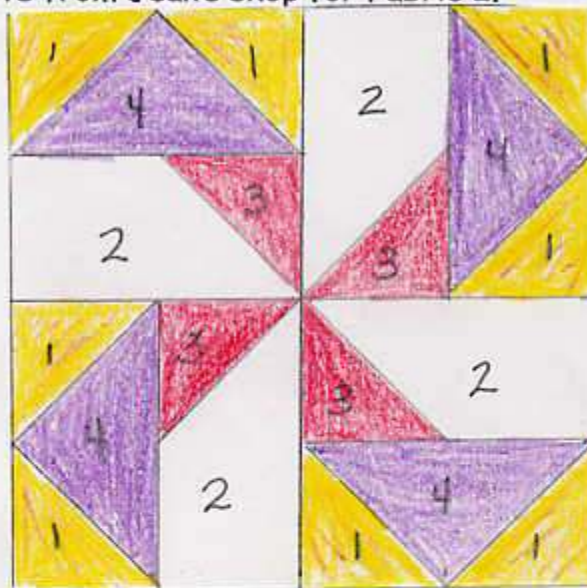


# A Touch of Amish

12" Finished Block

Use all solid colors for Fabric 1, 3, and 4 with white from Jean's shop for Fabric 2.

- Fabric 1: Cut (8)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares  
 Fabric 2 (white): Cut (4) rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "  
 Fabric 3: Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares  
 Fabric 4: Cut (4) rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

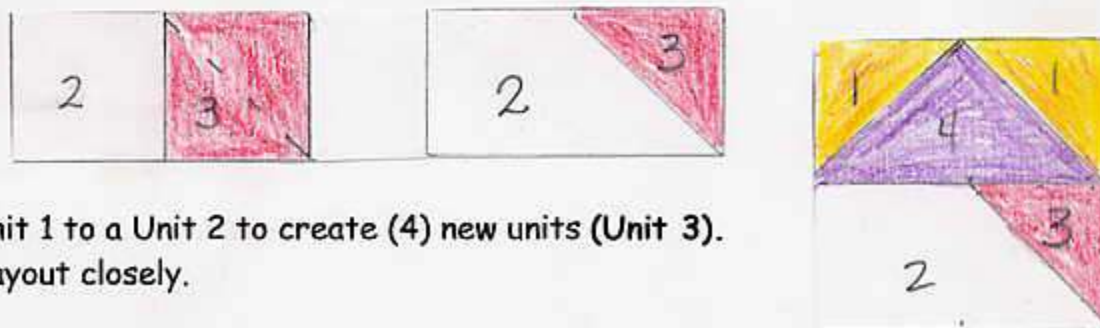


## Instructions

**Unit 1 Flying Geese unit:** On the wrong side of the Fabric 1 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square), draw a line from corner to corner. Place one Fabric 1 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square) on the right side of Fabric 4 rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim off excess at  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press out. Place another Fabric 1 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square) on the opposite corner and sew on the drawn line. Trim off excess at  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press out. Makes (4) flying geese units.



**Unit 2 Half-Flying Geese Unit:** On the wrong side of the Fabric 3 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square), draw a line from corner to corner. Place one Fabric 3 ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square) on the right side of the Fabric 2 rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim off excess at  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press out. Makes (4) half-flying geese units.



Sew a Unit 1 to a Unit 2 to create (4) new units (Unit 3).  
 Follow layout closely.

Sew two Unit 3 assemblies together to create (2) rows. Sew rows together to complete block.
