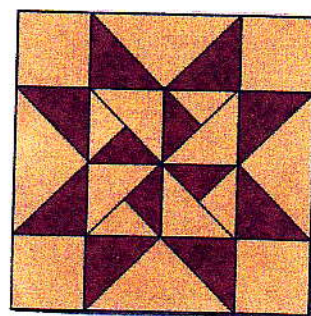

DEWEY'S VICTORY – 12"

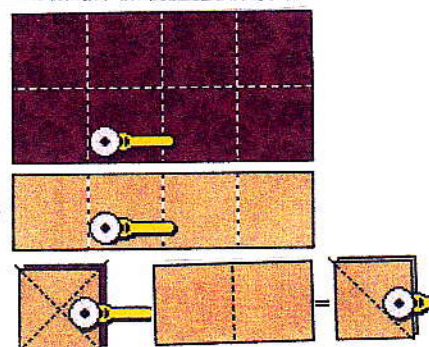


Supply list

Color one (blue & green) one 7" x 14" strip and one 4-1/4" square

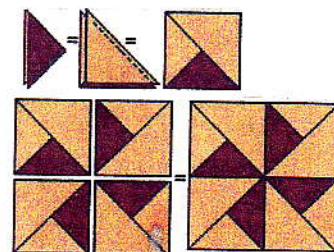
Color two (white muslin from Jean' Corner) one 3-1/2" x 14" strip and one 4-1/4" square and one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip and one 3-1/2" x 26" strip.

Cut the color one 7" x 14" strip into eight 3-1/2" squares. Then cut the color two 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares. Stack the color one and the color two 4-1/4" squares, with all edges aligned, and cut them once on each diagonal to make 4 quarter square triangles of each color. Then cut the color two 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip into two 3-7/8" squares. Stack those with edges aligned and cut them in half once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles.

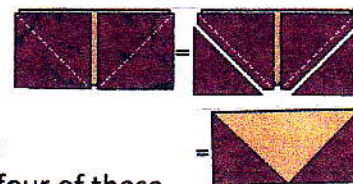


Next cut the color two 3-1/2" x 26" strip into four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.

Using a scant 1/4" seam allowance, sew together pairs of the quarter square triangles with color one always on the right, pressing seams to the darker side. sew a color two half square triangle to each of these pairs. Press seam towards color two. Make four units like this. Trim to measure 3-1/2" if needed. Sew the four of those together to form the block's center unit.



Now, to make one side unit, place a color one square, right sides together, atop a color two rectangle, with the outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark the diagonal. Sew on this diagonal marking. Cut off excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another color one square on the other side of the rectangle. Make four of these.



Now lay our all units as shown at right. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the center, and the middle row seam to the outside. Sew the rows together and you are done!
