BLOCK OF THE MONTH FEBRUARY, 2013

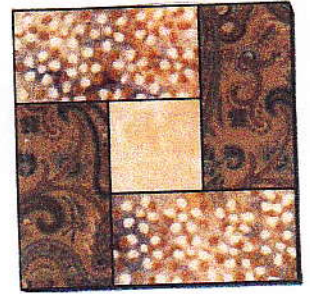
TWIST - 12"

Supply list

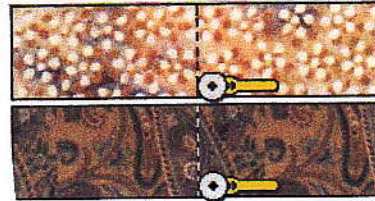
Color one needs one 4-1/2"x 17" strip - purple

Color two needs one 4-1/2"x 17" strip - lavender

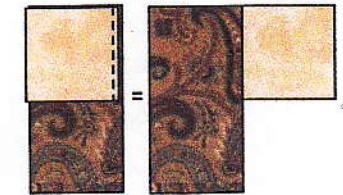
Color three (natural muslin from Jean's Corner) needs one 4-1/2" square



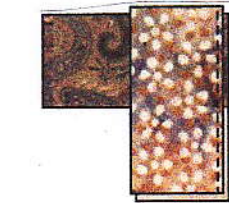
Start by marking and cutting the color one and the color two 4-1/2"x 17" strips into two 4-1/2"x 1-1/2" rectangles of each color.



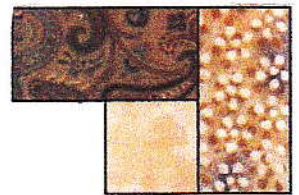
Sew the color three background square to the right side of a color two rectangle, edges aligned and right sides together, using a SCANT 1/4" seam. Press seam allowance towards rectangle.



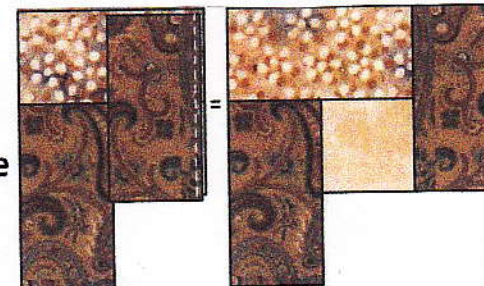
Next sew a color one rectangle to the top of the previously made unit, pressing seam allowance toward top rectangle.



Then sew the remaining color two rectangle to the right side of the previously made unit, pressing seam towards the right side rectangle.



Now place the last color one rectangle lined up with the right hand edge of the block, right sides together and sew from the outer right hand edge in towards the center, stopping 1/4" before the edge of that piece...keep needle down.



Fold the block towards you to line up the remaining un-sewn seam...and stitch from your stopping point to the edge. Done
