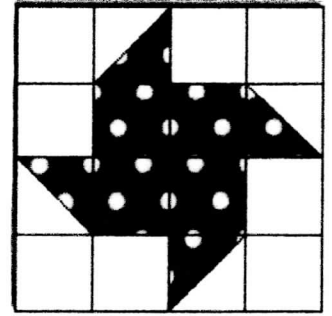


LIVINGSTON PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH/FEBRUARY 2015

PAPER PINWHEELS



Supply list

Color one needs one 3-1/2" x 14" strip and one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip. (any bright color)

Color two needs two 3-1/2" x 14" strips and one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip. (white muslin from Jean's Corner)

First mark and cut the color one and color two 3-1/2" x 14" strips into four 3-1/2" squares of color one and eight of color two.

Now stack the color one and color two 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strips, right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the top strip lightly draw in the 3-7/8" square line, then mark in the diagonals as well. Sew 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals. Cut apart on the square line and on the marked diagonals between the rows of stitching. This will give you four half squares. Press seams towards the darker fabrics. These should measure 3-1/2" square.

Now just piece the block by sewing together four rows as shown at right, using the units just made. Press the seams in alternating directions by row to keep your seams lying nice and flat.
