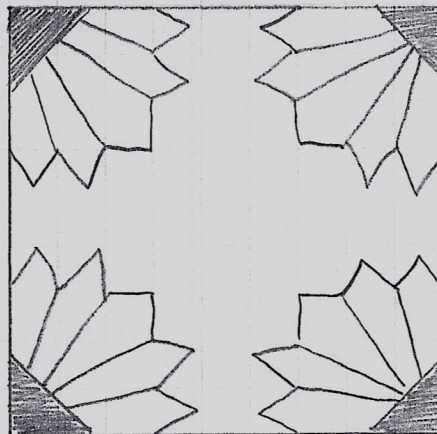


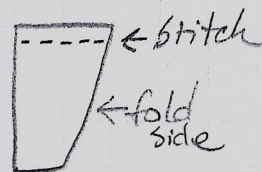
Quarter Dresden Plate

- 1-14" cream guild muslin
- 4- 3" dark blue squares
- 20- floral Dresden plates



14" unfinished

1. Take the dresden templet and cut 20 floral dresden plates
Templet below.
2. Fold the big end right sides together and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams from the big end. Stitch toward the fold for less slippage.

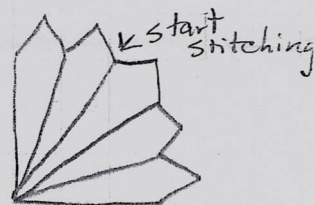


Take and turn right sides out. This should give you a dresden plate with a point.

← $4\frac{3}{4}$ " →

Press w/ starch.

4. Make 4 sets of 5 dresden plates. Matching points and sew to the end. Press all seams in one direction.

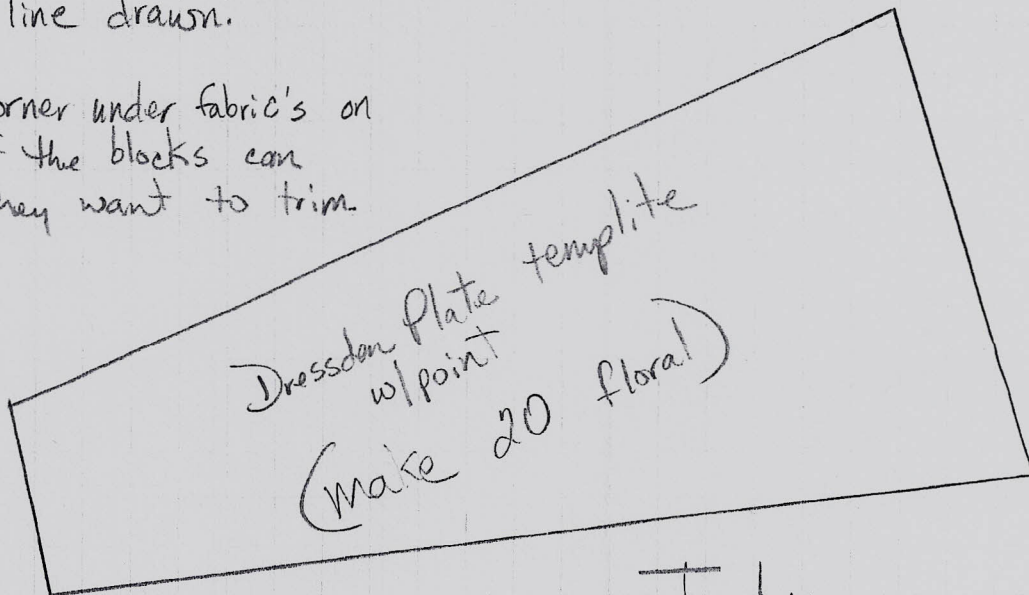


make 4 units

5. Pin the units in each corner of the muslin. Stitch the units in place using an $\frac{1}{8}$ " seam along the corners.

6. Taking the 3" squares draw a line from corner to corner. Lay the sq. right sides together down on each corner. stitch on the line drawn.

* leave the corner under fabric's on
The winner of the blocks can decide if they want to trim or not
