

LIVINGSTON PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH JANUARY, 2013

SNOWBALL – 12"

Supply list

Color one needs four 6-1/2" squares – each a different blue.

Color two (white muslin from Jean's Corner) needs one 5" x 20" strip

---

Mark and cut the color two 5"x 20" strip into sixteen 2-1/2" squares.

Then lay a color two 2-1/2" square atop of the top left corner of the first blue print 6-1/2" square, right sides together and edges aligned. On the back of the top small square, lightly draw the diagonal in the direction shown at right. Sew on this marked line. Cut off the excess seam allowance, and press the remainder towards the outside. Repeat with another small square in the opposing corner, and then with the other two corners.

Now piece the four "snowballs" to make the block Sooooo simple!
