BLOCK OF THE MONTH/JANUARY, 2014

NEXT DOOR NEIGHBOR – 12"

Supply list

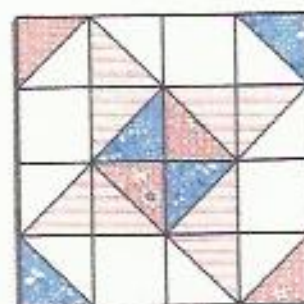
Color one needs one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip (blue)

Color two needs one 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strip (lavender)

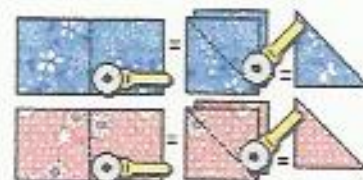
Color three needs one 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strip (dark pink or rose)

These fabrics can be plain for with designs

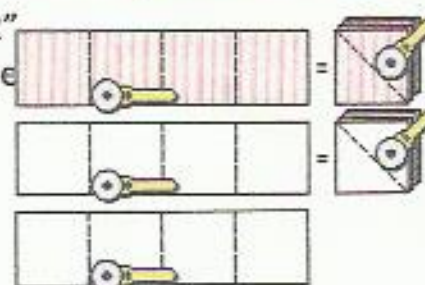
Color four needs one 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strip and one 3-1/2" x 14" strip
(natural muslin from Jean's)



First mark and cut the color one and color two 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strips into two 3-7/8" squares of each. Stack these and cut on the diagonal once to make four half square triangles of each.

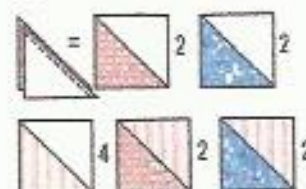


Then make and cut the color three and color four 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strips into four 3-7/8" squares of each. Stack these and cut on the diagonal once to make eight half square triangles of each.

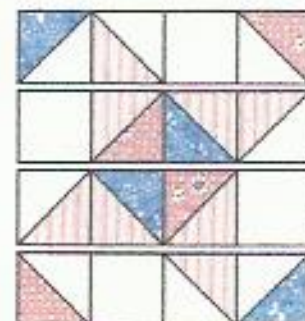


Now mark and cut the color four 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares.

Make half squares as shown at right, using all scant 1/4" seams. The numbers you need of each color combination are shown at right. Press seam allowances towards the darker fabrics.



Next make rows in the order shown at right. Press all seam allowances in one direction for the first row, the opposite for the second row, etc. Sew the rows together to make the block.



The block should measure 12-1/2"
