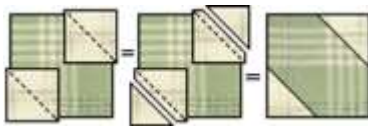
Block of the Month—June 2016

Prairie Flower ** Note: size is 14" unfinished**

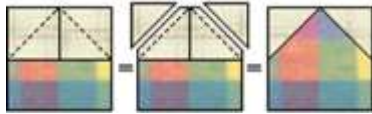


Fabric 1—cream (from Jean's Corner): cut (1) 5" square, (16) 2 1/2" squares
 Fabric 2—pink print: cut (4) 5" squares
 Fabric 3—blue print: cut (4) 5" squares

1. Mark diagonal line on back of each cream 2 1/2" square.
2. Place cream squares on opposite corners of a blue print 5" square. Sew diagonally from corner to corner on the wrong side of the small cream square. Trim the corner to 1/4" and press the resulting triangle toward the corner of the block to form a small "snowball" corner. Square should measure 5". Make 4 units.



3. Place a 2 1/2" cream square on one corner of a pink print square. Sew diagonally from corner to corner across the cream square and trim to 1/4". Press the resulting triangle toward the print. Repeat once more for the adjacent corner. Make 4 of these units.



4. Now lay out all the units, with the extra cream 5" square as the center. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the center and the middle row seam to the outside. Join the rows and you are all done!
