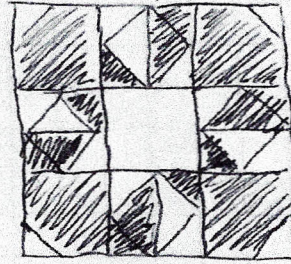


# Disappearing Hourglass

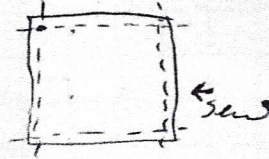
- 60% Cream Muslin 10" sq
- Fabric 10" sq

RST Right Sides Together  
 HST Half Sq Triangles

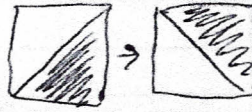


11 3/4" unfinished

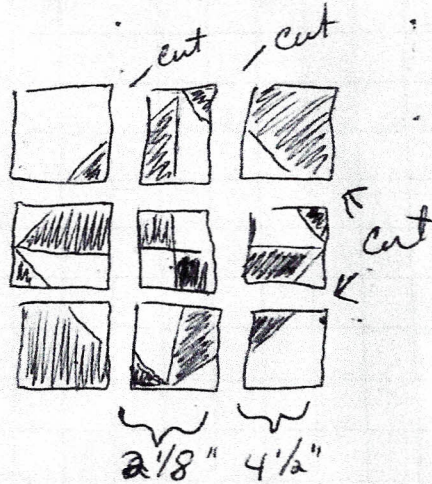
1) Lay the cream + fabric dark RST  
 Sew 1/4" around. Sew off  
 the ends.



2) Cut across the sq diagonal  
 twice - 1/2 HST. Press  
 seams to the dark.  
 Arrange the HST to create  
 an hour glass block. Sew  
 busting the seam

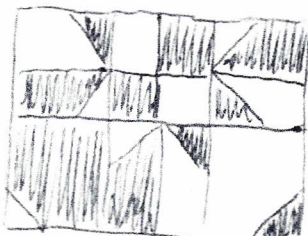
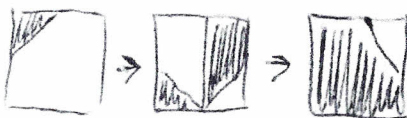


3) Sq up the hour glass block to  
 12 3/4. Each of the 9 sq  
 will measure 4 1/4 once cut.  
 Cut 2 1/8" away from center  
 seam on both sides.

4.) Turn each of the outside 8  
 sq. 180° - the center 90° Follow  
 the diagram Sew the  
 3 blocks of each row together.  
 Press to where the seams will  
 nestle together.
