BLOCK OF THE MONTH/MARCH, 2014

BUCKEYE BEAUTY – 12"

Supply list

Color one needs two 3-1/2" squares and one 6-7/8" square - lavender or purple

Color two needs two 3-1/2" squares – green

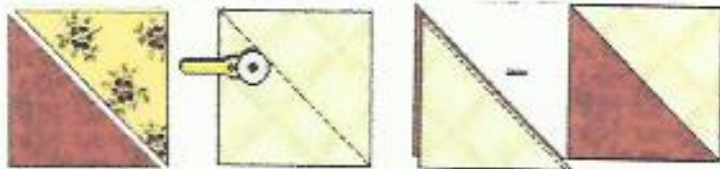
Color three needs one 3-1/2" x 14" strip - yellow

Color four needs one 6-7/8" square - yellow floral

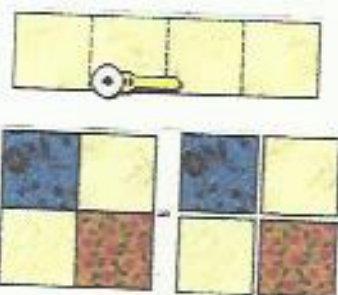
Color five needs one 6-7/8" square (white muslin from Jean's)



Cut the three 6-7/8" squares in half on the diagonal. Sew one color one and one color four triangle to the color five triangles using a scant 1/4" seam. Trim these units to 6-1/2" squares.



Cut the color three 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares. Then sew color one and color two squares to two color three squares as shown at right using a scant 1/4" seam. This unit should measure 6-1/2". Do this step twice.



Now lay out the four units as shown at right. Sew two horizontal rows, pressing the row seams in alternating directions. Join the rows to make the Buckeye Beauty.



The block should measure 12-1/2"
