


## BLOCK OF THE MONTH/MARCH 2015 JOHNNY AROUND THE CORNER


## Supply list

Color one needs one 3-1/2" x 14" strip and one 4" x 13" strip. (green) Color two needs one 4" x 16" strip and one 4" x 13" strip (natural muslin from Jean's Corner)
Color three needs one 6-1/2" square (floral)

Start by cutting the color one  $3-1/2" \times 14"$  strip into four 3-1/2" squares. Then cut the color one  $4" \times 13"$  strip into four  $2" \times 6-1/2"$  rectangles.

Next cut the color two 4" x 16" strip into sixteen 2" squares. Now cut the color two 4" x 13" strip into four 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.





To sew the block's corner units, place a color two 2" square right sides together atop the top left corner of a color one 3-1/2" square, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square, lightly draw the diagonal, then sew on this line. Cut off the excess seam allowance, and press the remainder towards the outer triangle. Repeat this with another color two square on the opposing corner, and then on the two adjacent corners. Make four units like this. These should measure 3-1/2".

Next sew together the side units by sewing a color one and a color two 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle together along one long edge, using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to darker side. Make four units like this. These should measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2".



Now lay out all of the blocks units as shown at right, with the color three 6-1/2" floral block as the center unit. Sew three horizontal rows and then join the rows to finish up your Johnny Around the Corner block.

This block should measure 12-1/2"
