TULIP LADYFINGERS – 12"

Supply list

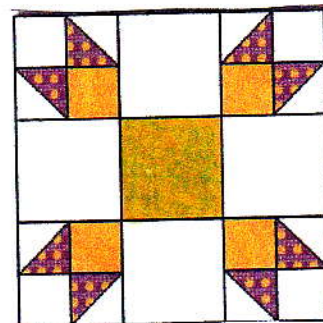
Color one needs one 4-1/2" square (green)

Color two needs one 2-1/2"x 10" strip (pastel)

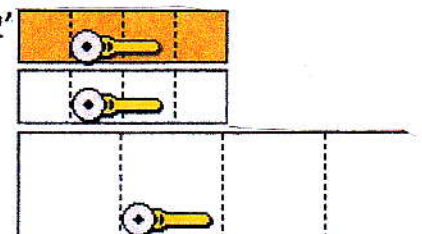
Color three needs one 2-7/8"x 11-1/2" strip (pastel)

Color four needs one 2-1/2"x 10" strip, one 4-1/2"x 18" strip

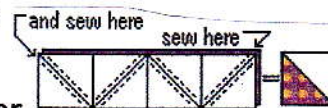
and one 2-7/8"x 11-1/2" strip (white muslin from Jean's)



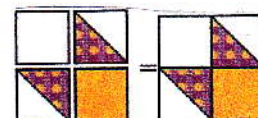
Cut the color two and color four 2-1/2" x 10" strips into four 2-1/2" squares each. Cut the color four 4-1/2" x 18" strip into four 4-1/2" strips.



Stack the color three and the color four 2-7/8" x 11-1/2" strips, right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the top strip, lightly mark the 2-7/8" square line and mark the diagonals in the directions shown at right. Now sew a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals, pivoting at the square lines. Now cut apart on the marked diagonals and on the 2-7/8" square line. This will give you eight half squares. Press seams towards the darker fabric. Trim these to measure 2-1/2".



Now sew four of the corner units shown at right. These should measure 4-1/2".



Lay out all units as shown below. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the outside and the middle row seam to the center. Join the rows and you are done!
