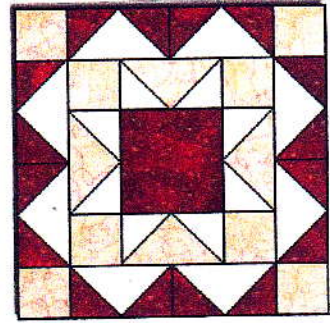


LIVINGSTON PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH SEPTEMBER, 2012

EDDYSTONE LIGHT – 12"



Supply list

Color one needs one 4-1/2" square and one 5" x 20" strip

Color two needs one 2-1/2" x 20" strip and one 2-1/2" x 18" strip

Color three (white muslin from Jean's Corner)

needs one 2-1/2" x 20" strip and one 5" x 18" strip

Cut the color one 5" x 20" strip into sixteen 2-1/2" squares.
Cut the color two and the color three 2-1/2" x 20" strips
into eight 2-1/2" squares.

Now cut the color two 2-1/2" x 18" strip into four
2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and the color three 5" x 18"
strip into eight 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

To make the flying geese unit, place a color one square
right sides together atop a color three rectangle, with
outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly
mark the diagonal. Sew on this diagonal marking. Cut off
the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards
the corner. Repeat this with another color one square on
the other end of the rectangle. Make eight geese in this
color arrangement and four using the color two rectangles
and the color three squares.

Next sew two of each of the side units shown at right,
using the standard scant 1/4" seam allowance now and
throughout the block making.

Now make one center star unit as shown at right.

Now lay out all units like the one below. Sew the shorter side units
to the sides of the star unit. Press seams toward the center. Add
the longer side units to the top and bottom and the block is complete.
