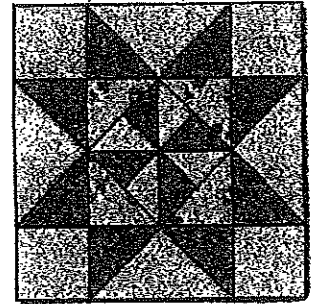


LIVINGSTON PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH/SEPTEMBER, 2013

SOLOMON'S STAR – 12"



Supply list

Color one needs one 7"X 14" strip and one 4-1/4" square (darker green)

Color two needs one 3-7/8"x 7-3/4" strip (lighter green print)

Color three needs one 3-1/2"x 14" strip and one 3-1/2" x 26" strip

and one 4-1/4" square (white muslin from Jean's Corner)

Cut the color one 7"x 14" strip into eight 3-1/2" squares.

Cut the color three 3-1/2"x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares.

Next cut the color two 3-7/8"x 7-3/4" strip into two 3-7/8" squares.

Stack those squares and cut once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles.

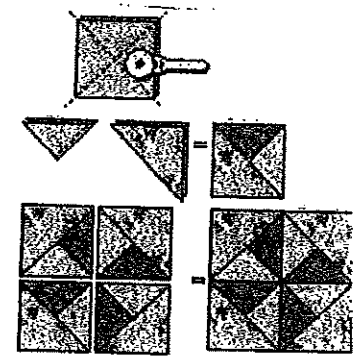
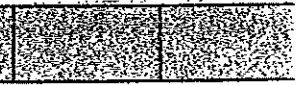
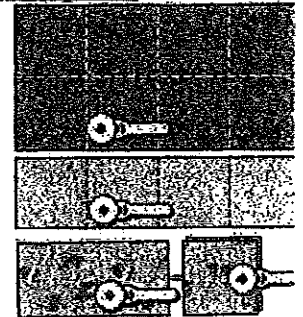
Then cut the color three 3-1/2"x 26" strip into four 3-1/2"x 6-1/2" rectangles.

To make one flying geese unit, place a color one square right sides together atop a color three rectangle, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark the diagonal. Sew on this diagonal line.

Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another color one square on the other end of the rectangle. Make four of these.

Now stack the color one and the color three 4-1/4" squares. Cut on both diagonals to make four quarter square triangles of each.

Sew together pairs of color one/color three quarter square triangles using the standard SCANT 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam to the darker side. Sew a color two half square triangle to this pieced triangle. Press seam towards color two.



Sew four of those together to make the clock's center unit.

Now lay out all units as shown at right. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the center, and the middle row seams to the outside. Sew the rows together and you are all done. 😊

Block should measure 12-1/2 "
