### **Sewing tips for charity projects**

**Do your very best work for those in need.**

**Matching thread is a good idea except with decorative top stitching. Using grey is okay. Always clean up your work. Clip curves so items will lay flat, clip threads and always press. Please use new or very good fabrics - absolutely no stains.**

**When finishing knitted helmet liners, please run in all loose threads and cut them off, but not close to any knots!**

**All quilts should be tied or quilted within 8 inches.**

**Habitat House blocks should be 12 inches finished. Any type of house block will be fine - applique, painted, printed, pieced...**
